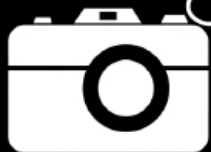

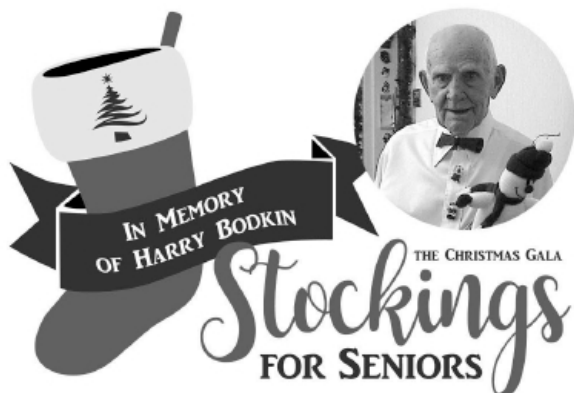

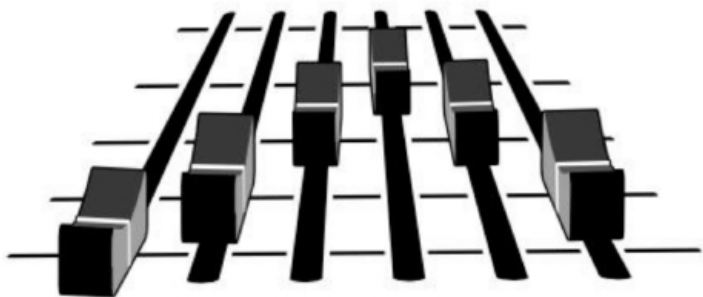

LIFE St. Mary is an innovative program for people age 55 and older with chronic health problems and/or memory loss. For those who qualify, **LIFE** assists older adults in navigating the healthcare system and addressing the needs of the whole person. Services include primary and specialty medical care, medications, personal care at home, activities at a day center, meals and transportation.

The goal of **LIFE St. Mary** is to provide services so aging adults can avoid moving to a nursing home and continue to live at home. The **LIFE** Center provides one location where doctors, nurses, and other healthcare professionals offer treatment and monitor changes in participants' health.

Who is eligible for LIFE St. Mary?

Age 55 or older • Live in the Life Service area • Need the level of care that requires nursing facility-type services • Can live safely in the community with the services provided through LIFE St. Mary
