A word from our Founder

Tonight we are celebrating the tenth year of being a non-profit. Many of you have no idea why you are here tonight, others have been with us for many years and others since day one. The name throws everyone one off at first and to be honest it has been a challenge for the past ten years. A challenge that many of my team have taken on with a smile. I can spend the time here telling you about how we started and what we have been doing for the past years but I would lose you within the first three sentences. Do you know why? Have you ever wondered why we have to fight so hard to be heard on social media or filling seats at events?

I used to wonder. So I started to attend other events for other non-profits to watch and learn. It turns out I was doing all the right things. The events were fun and interesting. Everyone put a lot of work into each and every event and attendance was good. Most of all we were making a difference to our seniors in need. Who would have thought that giving away gifts and helping with utility bills would turn into a full time non paying job. Well it did. In the past years we have given away hundreds of thousands of in kind donations along with actual cash assistance.

We are the best kept secret around. We receive an average of 10 calls a week asking for help with all types of needs. Asking for help with electric, water, rent, food, propane and more is an everyday event for the Christmas Gala. The challenge we have is getting the word out to all of you; people who come to events because the event looked fun and really had no idea what they were supporting; gaining the support of larger businesses to take us on under their wing to support us.

So tonight I am asking that each of you spread the word that we help seniors over the age of 60 who other wise would not get any help. We spend hours on a phone sometimes just listening to a client in need. WE spend six months preparing to collect over a 1000 gifts and work with over 50 business who host a tree with all the request on them and work with over 30 organizations that supply us with names to be able to send the gifts to. On average we are able to solve the problem for at least half of the requests received in each week.

Most of all please share we are always looking ways to help support our mission and make the wishes of so many to come true. Thank you to each and everyone one of you for supporting us tonight and hope you all stick around with us to see where we go

Our success story

- Everyone likes a good story and this year our story begins with how much we have helped our community. 2018 has been very long and mentally challenging for all of us. Homelessness seems to be a large problem for our seniors. The problems are so many, that we can't possibly help everyone and we are not able to make a dent with our current programs. So we had to make some changes this year. Those changes will be announced in January.
- So far in 2018 we have received 141 calls for our EPIC program. People asking for help with electric, water, rent, security deposits, air conditioners, sofas, couches, hotel costs, medications, beds, bed supplies, house supplies, depends, vet costs, medical help, rides to doctors, home health care agencies to help seniors during transitions, glasses, propane, oil, car payments (exception to our rules) and much more. We have answered all of these calls plus more. Seniors call the office for help and our volunteers take the time to listen to their needs and try to find a solution. Keep in mind there are no paid employees at our office. Everyone comes to help to make a difference in the community.
- Over the past year we have had to deny requests for moving, fixing a roof, bladder acupuncture, washer and dryers, car repairs, bed bugs, fixing a heater and more. Out of 141 calls we denied about 20 of them. A rough number of how much we paid out is around \$24,000.00 in requests for help. This is not including the angel program overhead expenses and all the hours of the team members.
- What you don't see is the the thousands of cards we collect, hundreds of pieces of candy, hundreds of gift bags and all the gifts that will be donated to fill around 1,100 requests from our seniors and organizations we work with. Last years our in kind donations valued around \$55.000.00. We can only hope to be so fortunate this coming year. So when you see a fundraiser is up and running for us please support and help us keep the doors open.





LIFE St. Mary is an innovative program for people age 55 and older with chronic health problems and/or memory loss. For those who qualify, LIFE assists older adults in navigating the healthcare system and addressing the needs of the whole person. Services include primary and specialty medical care, medications, personal care at home, activities at a day center, meals and transportation.

The goal of LIFE St. Mary is to provide services so aging adults can avoid moving to a nursing home and continue to live at home. The LIFE Center provides one location where doctors, nurses, and other healthcare professionals offer treatment and monitor changes in participants' health.

Who is eligible for LIFE St. Mary?

Age 55 or older • Live in the Life Service area • Need the level of care that requires nursing facility-type services • Can live safely in the community with the services provided through LIFE St. Mary
